



Key features

Sports:

- Competition-size swimming pool with renovated bathhouse
- New multiuse field with artificial turf big enough for cricket, football or soccer
- New six lane 1/4-mile track with rubberized surface
- Reconstituted youth baseball field
- New sand volleyball courts near picnic pavilions
- Maintain existing tennis and basketball courts

Health & Fitness:

- Adult fitness equipment adjacent to Recreation Center with shade structure
- New 1.5 mile bicycle and walking trail around park with bridges and boardwalk where needed
- New community garden near Recreation Center
- Potential connection to PATH South River Trail along Doolittle Creek

Play and Recreation:

- New toddler playground next to existing playground with parent shade structure between
- New splashpad associated with reopened swimming pool
- New small playground near picnic pavilions
- Two new 1-acre dog parks for both small and large dogs

Events and Comfort:

- New concession/restroom building near sports fields
- New restroom building near picnic pavilions
- Gated and locked waste management enclosure
- Drinking fountains near dog park and sports fields
- New bleachers around sports fields
- Additional shade structures near basketball courts and playgrounds
- Two additional picnic pavilions

Parking and Access:

- New gated vehicular entrance off Mark Trail to access picnic pavilions
- New pedestrian entrances on Mark Trail, Tilson Circle and Lullwood Trail
- Approximately 90-100 new parking spaces
- Vehicle loading zone for picnic pavilions
- New directional and entrance signage
