Letter Writing Tips

.....

-  Include a simple greeting, like "Dear Park Worker," or "Dear Courageous Park Crew."
-  Include a personal "thank you" or show gratitude for their efforts and perseverance to keep the parks beautiful during this difficult time.
-  Keep it positive! If you need to report a maintenance issue in your park, please do so using the appropriate channels and stick to expressions of gratitude in your letter.
-  Avoid including additional items in your envelope.
-  Get a stamp!
