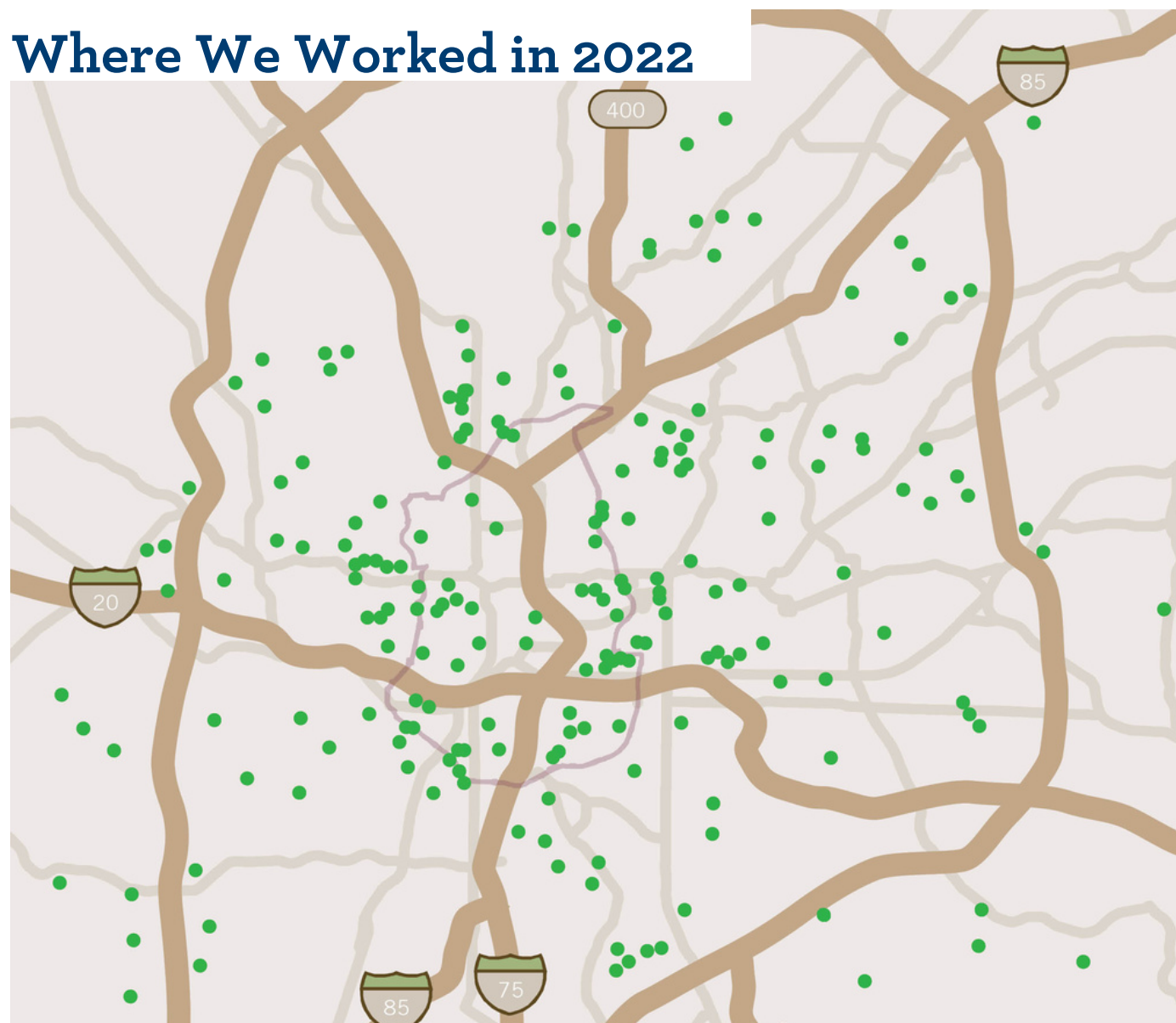

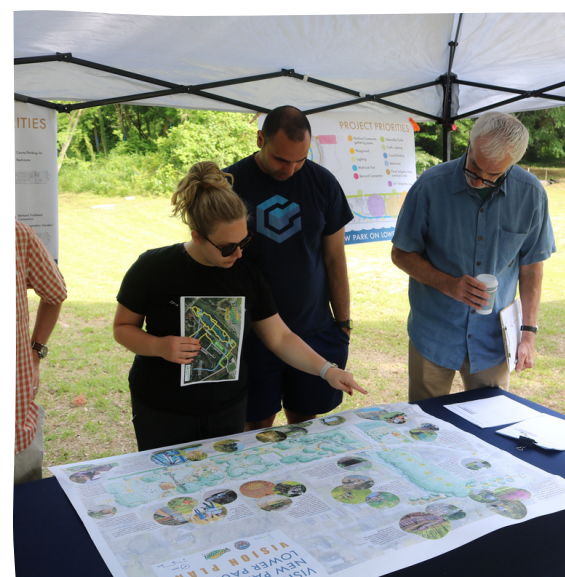


## MEMORABLE HIGHLIGHTS
